



Master Hornsmith and Journeyman Leatherworker, Erwin Tschanz

Erwin Tschanz will be the featured speaker at the Town of Ontario Historical and Landmark Preservation Society's general dinner meeting on **Wednesday, November 9<sup>th</sup>** at the **North Ontario United Methodist Church, 7200 Ontario Center Rd., Ontario, NY**. For the Bicentennial Mr. Tschanz assisted in forming a reenactment unit of the Brigade of the American Revolution. At that time he began making horn, bone and leather items. He is a member of the Rochester Woodworkers' Guild, Finger Lakes Wood Turners and the American Association of woodturners. His work, both horn and tree, has been selected for inclusion in the Early American Life Directory of Traditional American Craftsmen for the past 4 years, and is represented in the reenacting community both in the United States and abroad.
