Inspector Schooling Starting Early

Listed at the left are the schooling dates for 2016.

To become a Certified Election Inspector it is mandatory that you attend schooling every year. You only need to attend one class.

YOU MUST CALL OUR OFFICE AND RESERVE A SEAT!

Class size is limited to 25 people.

All classes will begin promptly at 9:30 AM. Please make every effort to arrive on time, no more than 15 minutes early.

Classes will last approximately 4 hours. There will **not** be a lunch or beverage provided. Therefore, you may bring a snack and a beverage of your own.

Again, the Chair and Backup Chair will be appointed by our office. This year we are **mandating** that all Chairmen and Backup Chairs stay for a Chairman class after the Certification training (approximately 45 minutes to one hour). If you do not stay for this instruction, you will not be appointed as a Chair for 2016.

No other Chairman class will be offered.

Location of Inspector Schooling for 2016



All classes will be held at the Public Safety Building, 7376 State Route 31, Lyons, in the Operations Room on the 2nd floor.

WHERE IS THE VOTER'S SIGNATURE?

When doing voter history after the general election of 2015, we realized that many voters did not sign the poll book, but there was a stub number and initials of two inspectors. ?????

Please, please follow the procedure that you are taught in class.

Building not opened yet

Many phone calls received from inspectors stating that their poll site was not unlocked right at 5 AM. Please allow a few minutes for the person to get to all sites.

“We are missing supplies”

Our office has four to six people checking supplies and packing suitcases to assure all items are in your suitcases. Please thoroughly check all supplies to your checklists from each suitcase by laying out on the table and checking off your list.

Primary Reminders

It has been a while since Wayne County has had a two or more party primary. This year, however, will be different.

Only voters registered in one of the parties having a primary may vote in that primary. If the voter insists they are of one of the parties having the primary, give them an affidavit and colored ballot to vote and we will in-

vestigate here at the office.

Parties will have different election day ballots that will be colored on the stub and voter instruction area. It's very important that the voter gets the correct ballot.

Inspectors are urged to not rush through this process, but to work efficiently.
