

**DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S
2012 ANNUAL REPORT**

STAFF

District Attorney and three full-time Assistant District Attorneys handling felony prosecution in the Grand Jury and County Court.

Seven part-time Assistant District Attorneys handling misdemeanor, vehicle and traffic and petty offenses in the justice courts.

Two confidential secretaries, clerk typist, a victim-witness coordinator and a part-time criminal investigator.

PROSECUTIONS

The part-time Assistant District Attorneys prosecuted approximately 1,283 misdemeanor crimes in justice court, as well as traffic and petty offenses.

The full-time Assistant District Attorneys reviewed all felony arrests that totaled 550. 298 felony cases prosecuted in County Court by Grand Jury indictment and Superior Court Informations, the remainder were returned to Justice Court.

298 felony cases were disposed of during 2011 in County Court by guilty plea, dismissal or trial. 98% were convicted by plea or verdict. There were 8 felony County Court jury trials and 1 non-jury trials resulting in 6 convictions and 3 acquittals.

BUDGET

\$989,575 annual modified budget. \$120,989 revenues including \$31,800 State Aid to Prosecution grant and \$43,867 District Attorney salary reimbursement.
