Thank you for your interest in the Alasa Farms project. Below is a tentative prioritized list of buildings for consideration based on the understanding of the owners. The project committee will strongly consider recommendations of the selected consultant- see RFQ.

1. Main House (originally called the Church House) (c1834)
Access concerns- Obvious fire damage, please use caution
1st floor most rooms seem to be structurally sound;
2nd floor- please remain on carpeted or swept floors.
3rd floor – off limits for safety purposes
2. Shaker Museum (Board and batten barn with built-in corncrib; c1840s)
3. Cow barn (late 19th century with c1930 expansions and improvements),
4. West Barn (c1930)
5. Horse barn (1925-26),
6. Pony barn (pre-1926, possibly late 19th century)
7. Granary (1932)
8. Bachelor's Quarters (1926)
9. In-ground swimming pool and adjacent pool house (both c1926)
10. Goat Shed (date unknown, recent)

Please note- the four buildings are not available for today's walk-through.

11. Garage (1926), converted into farm office c1930
12. Deacon's House (c1834)
13. Tenant house-south (c1909)
14. Tenant house-north (c1909)
