The Board of Elections of the County of Wayne having met at the office of said Board on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 2009, to canvass and estimate the votes given in the several election districts of said County at the General Election held the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November, 2009, do certify as follows:

**That the whole number of votes given for the State and County Offices was 17,598 of which the candidates/proposals received the number of votes set opposite their names**

**PROPOSAL NUMBER ONE, AN AMENDMENT**

Amendment to section 1 of article 14 of the Constitution, in relation to the use of certain forest preserve lands by National Grid to construct a 46 kV power line along State Route 56 in St. Lawrence County.

The proposed amendment would authorize the Legislature to convey up to six acres of forest preserve land along State Route 56 in St. Lawrence County to National Grid for construction of a power line. In exchange, National Grid would convey to the State at least 10 acres of forest land in St. Lawrence County, to be incorporated into the forest preserve. The land to be conveyed by National Grid to the State must be at least equal in value to the land conveyed to National Grid by the State. Shall the proposed amendment be approved? Yes or No
