

WHEREAS, Wayne County Resolution No. 330-22 authorized the release of an RFP, under the direction of the Economic Development and Planning Department, to solicit proposals from outside contractors for development of an Electric Vehicle Plan to identify the best locations for facilitation of EV charging station deployment and to secure and implement NYSEG Make-Ready Program and DEC Zero Emission Vehicles (ZEV) Program funding for implementation; and

WHEREAS, resolution 534-22 authorized an award but contained an error, and WHEREAS, proposals were received from the following firms:

WHEREAS, based on the scoring of the committee members, and the Purchasing Department's evaluation of the pricing provided by the firms, cumulative results score the E-3 Energy Advisors proposal highest, making it the evaluation team's recommendation to contract with E-3 Energy Advisors for completion of the Electric Vehicle Charging Station Location Plan; now, therefore, be it

WHEREAS, based on the scoring of the committee members, and the Purchasing Department's evaluation of the pricing provided by the firms, cumulative results score the MRB Group proposal highest, making it the evaluation team's recommendation to contract with MRB Group for completion of the Strategic Planning and Feasibility Study; now, therefore, be it
