## Wayne County

### County Positions open for 2021:

County Clerk: 4 year term

County Sheriff: 4 year term

County District Attorney: 4 year term

**Feb 16** Deadline for filing of Party Call from County Chairmen

\***Change of Enrollments** are effective immediately; except for those filed between Feb 16<sup>th</sup> (only for 2021 per Executive Order) - June 28<sup>th</sup>. Change of Enrollments filed between those dates will take effect June 29<sup>th</sup>.

### DESIGNATING PETITIONS

**March 2** First day for signing designating petitions

**March 22- 25** Filing dates for designating petitions

**March 29** Last day to accept or decline designation  
Last day to file authorization

**Apr 2** Last day to fill a vacancy after declination

Number of signatures needed for county position is based on 1.5% of the enrolled voters on Feb 21<sup>st</sup>, per Chapter 22 of the Laws of New York, 2021.

### INDEPENDENT PETITIONS FOR COUNTY

#### DATES AND SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS EXPECTED TO CHANGE

**April 13** First day for signing independent petitions

**May 18-25** Dates for filing independent nominating petitions

**May 28** Last day to accept or decline independent nomination

**June 1** Last day to fill vacancy after declination

Signatures needed for independent petitions based on 5% of total number of votes cast at the last gubernatorial election. (County Positions: 1568 signatures)

Remember that a county position can only be nominated by a designating or independent petition.

## **Town & Village**

### **Town and Village Positions for 2021:**

Please see the list of offices open for this year

#### **Caucus**

<b>March 2</b>	First day to hold town or village caucus
<b>July 21</b>	Last day to hold a town or village caucus
<b>July 22</b>	Last day to file Certificate of Nomination made at a caucus
<b>July 26</b>	Last day to accept or decline a nomination
<b>July 26</b>	Last day to file authorization
<b>July 30</b>	Last day to fill a vacancy after a declination from caucus

Please remember that a list of caucus participants needs to be filed with the Certificate of Nomination **for the village only**. A person can register the day of the caucus to participate and vote if of the party having the caucus. Call our office for more information.

#### **Caucus notices must be:**

Filed and posted in the town/village clerk's office **and** the board of elections at least **TEN DAYS** before the day of the caucus

**AND**

1. Posted either by newspaper publication once within the town/village at least one week and not more than two weeks preceding the caucus

**OR**

2. By posting in ten public places in the town or six public places within the village at least ten days preceding the caucus.

**\*Failure to comply with the above would make nominations null and void.**

In the Towns of Lyons, Macedon, Marion, Savannah and the Town and Villages of Sodus and Sodus Point, the **Republicans** have opted to nominate through the primary process instead of the caucus process. These candidates would pass Designating Petitions. Call for further information.

**\*Beginning in 2021, the Town of Wolcott Republicans are nominating by caucus.**

**Independent Petitions for Town & Village**  
**DATES AND SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS EXPECTED TO CHANGE**

- Apr 13**            First day to sign independent petition
- May 18-25**        Dates for filing independent petitions
- May 28**            Last day to accept or decline nomination
- June 1**            Last day to fill a vacancy after declination

Signature requirements for Independent Petitions for **Town only**– 5% of the total number of votes, excluding the blank and void, cast for the office of governor at the last gubernatorial election in the political unit. Please see attached for the signatures needed on town independent petitions.

**Village Signatures Needed for Independent Petitions**

<b>Village</b> of Red Creek	7 <del>13</del> Signatures	<i>Per Chapter 90 Signed 3/29/21</i>
<b>Village</b> of Sodus Point	15 <del>32</del> Signatures	

Village & Town Independent petitions are **different**. The number of signatures for a village is based on population at the last census or election.  
Make sure you have the correct **Town** or **Village Petition form**.

The only way to get on the ballot for a town or village position (with the exception of REPUBLICAN CANDIDATES IN THE: TOWN OF LYONS, MACEDON, MARION, SAVANNAH AND TOWN AND VILLAGES OF SODUS and SODUS POINT) is by caucus or independent petition. This prevents a primary for these towns/positions. Call our office with any questions.

**State & County Committee**

**State & County Committee**– the Republican and Conservative Parties file in Wayne County this year.

Please see the breakdown for number of signatures needed for each district within Wayne County. Remember that 25% of all districts, (times 2) for county committee, that means that at least 34 positions out of 134 are needed for that party to exist in Wayne County.

**7th Judicial Convention/Delegates & Alternates**  
**August 5-11, 2021**

**Democratic, Conservative and Working Families parties** of the Seventh Judicial District file with the NYS Board of Elections for 2021. **Republican Party** candidates for this office file their petitions in the county which contains their portion of the assembly district.

- Oct 8** Last day to postmark a new registration form to vote in General Election (must be rec'd in our office by Oct 13<sup>th</sup>)  
**OR** register in person at our office
- Oct 13** Last day for Board to **receive** a change of address within NYS
- Oct 23-31** Early Voting at the Board of Election's office

### **Absentee Voters for General Election**

- Oct 26** Last day to postmark absentee application or letter
- Nov 1** Last day to apply in person for absentee ballot
- Nov 2** Last day to postmark absentee ballot. We must receive ballot no later than November 9<sup>th</sup>
