



Wayne County Farmworker Housing Survey

Wayne County is asking farm owners to participate in a short survey to help define the need for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Farmworker Safety Housing Grant under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief And Economic Security Act (Cares). The survey will help design the program to benefit the most people. Note: There is a \$200,000 per farm limit on project reimbursement.

As part of this program, the farm business receiving a grant must collect and report an income certification for each individual farmworker or household benefiting from this project to document that the farm worker is low- to moderate-income.

We anticipate this program may contain two separate parts.

- o A mobile or manufactured home replacement program.
- o An HVAC or Air-handler replacement program.

Survey needs to be completed by 1/31/2022. If awarded, it is expected this program will begin later in the year.
