Meningitis survivor, GSK Spokesperson and Para -Athlete.
Jamie is a survivor who contracted meningitis as a 20yr old college student. The disease process resulted in the amputation of her legs and fingers. The 2009 Senate Bill # 819, named after her, now requires college students to have the meningococcal vaccination (ACWY) for entrance.

State Public Health Veterinarian, NYSDOH

Dr. Newman worked full time as a small animal clinical veterinarian from 1991-2002. She returned to study and completed her Masters in Public Health in 2004. She worked as a CDC Epidemic Intelligence Service (EIS) officer assigned to the Wisconsin Dept. of Health. She is now the NYSDOH State Health

Veterinarian & the director of the Regional Epidemiology and Investigations program in the Bureau of Communicable Disease Control.
