

A local law affecting compensation of county elected and appointed officers during their term of office (insert title)

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the (Name of Legislative Body)

Section 1. The annual salary of the Superintendent of Highways shall be, and it is hereby increased from \$19,000.00 per year to \$19,690.00 effective January 1, 1974.

Section 2. The annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be, and it is hereby increased from \$18,000.00 per year to \$19,000.00 per year effective January 1, 1974.

Section 3. The annual salaries of the County Judges (Family and Surrogates) shall be, and they are hereby increased from \$29,075.00 per year to \$29,865.00 per year effective January 1, 1974.

Section 4. The annual salary of the Wayne County Treasurer shall be, and it is hereby increased from \$15,000.00 per year to \$17,500.00 per year effective January 1, 1974.

Section 5. The annual salary of the Director of Real Property Tax Service shall be, and it is hereby increased from \$12,500.00 per year to \$15,000.00 per year effective January 1, 1974.

Section 6. This local law shall take effect immediately upon final passage and due filing.


