RESOLUTION NO. 246-94

**ADOPT LOCAL LAW
AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 1-1993**

Mr. Switzer presented the following:

WHEREAS, a proposed local law in relation to amending Local Law No. 1-1993 establishing the position of County Administrator for the County of Wayne was presented to the Board of Supervisors on March 15, 1994; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed local law was held by the Board of Supervisors on April 19, 1994, in accordance with the notice of hearing duly posted and published in the manner prescribed by law; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that said local law is hereby adopted to read as follows:

COUNTY OF WAYNE - STATE OF NEW YORK

A Local Law amending Local Law No. 1-1993 establishing the position of County Administrator for the County of Wayne.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAYNE, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Subdivision (a) of Section 3 of Local Law No. 1-1993 entitled "A Local Law Establishing the Position of County Administrator for the County of Wayne" is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) The County Administrator shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The term of office of the first County Administrator appointed pursuant to this local law shall commence on the date of such appointment and shall expire on December 31, 1995. Each appointment thereafter shall be for a term of two years ending on the last day of December in each odd numbered year. Every original appointment to the position of County Administrator shall be for a probationary term of not less than eight nor more than twenty-six weeks. Appointment to fill a vacancy in the office of County Administrator shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term."

SECTION 2.

Subdivision (c) of Section 3 of said local law is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(c) The appointee need not be a resident of Wayne County at the time of appointment but shall become so within 90 days of permanent appointment and remain so during the appointee's term of office. Failure to become such a resident as provided herein or to remain such a resident shall be cause for dismissal by the Board of Supervisors."

SECTION 3.

Item 12 in Section 4 of said local law is hereby amended to read as follows:

"12. have such additional duties as may now or hereafter be determined by the Board of Supervisors."

SECTION 4.

This local law shall take effect on the date it is filed in the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby directed to number the local law in conformance with the filing requirements of the Secretary of State and to file the local law with the Secretary of State in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

Mr. Colvin moved the adoption of the resolution. Seconded by Mrs. Chittenden. Upon roll call, all Supervisors voted Aye except Supervisors Spickerman, DeLisio, Fabino and Lyon who voted Nay. Absent - Supervisors Prober and Deyo. The Chairman declared the resolution adopted.
