RESOLUTION NO. 145-99: ADOPT LOCAL LAW IN RELATION TO REGULATING PARKING IN THE RESERVED PARKING AREA ADJACENT TO THE PEARL STREET COUNTY OFFICE BUILDING

Mr. Guelli presented the following:

WHEREAS, a proposed local law in relation to regulating parking in the reserved parking area adjacent to the Pearl Street County Office Building was presented to the Board of Supervisors on January 19, 1999; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed local law was held by the Board of Supervisors on February 23, 1999, in accordance with the notice of hearing duly posted and published in the manner prescribed by law; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that said local law is hereby adopted to read as follows:

COUNTY OF WAYNE - STATE OF NEW YORK

A local law amending Local Law No. 5-1985, as amended by Local Law No. 2-1988 and Local Law No. 4-1993, in relation to regulating parking in the reserved parking area adjacent to the Pearl Street County Office Building.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAYNE, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Section 2 of Local Law No. 5-1985 entitled "A Local Law Designating a Reserved Parking Area Adjacent to Pearl Street County Office Building and Adopting Regulations Governing Parking in Such Area", as amended by Local Law No. 2-1988 and 4-1993, is hereby amended to read as follows:
