STATE OF NEW YORK

A LOCAL LAW RELATING TO THE REAPPORTIONMENT  
OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY  
OF WAYNE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY  
OF WAYNE, STATE OF NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

It is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Wayne County by this Local Law to comply with the constitutional requirement recently established by the Supreme Court of the United States and the Court of Appeals of the State of New York.

SECTION 2. THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The Supervisors of the several towns in Wayne County when lawfully convened shall, on and after the first day of January 1968, constitute the Board of Supervisors of the County of Wayne, and shall continue to be known and designated as the Board of Supervisors, but their respective votes as such members thereof shall, on and after the first day ;of January 1968, be determined and fixed in accordance with the provisions of this Local Law to accomplish the reapportionment of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Wayne.

SECTION 3. VOTING STRENGTH

The apportionment of the voting strength of the members of the Board of Supervisors shall be determined by the 1966 special federal census in the County of Wayne, until the next decennial federal census, in which event the voting strength shall be changed, if necessary, to conform to such decennial federal census. On and after the first day of January 1968,

and continuing until the next decennial federal census unless an official county census shall be made sooner, each supervisor elected within the respective towns of Wayne County shall be entitled to the following number of votes on any resolution, local law, motion or proposal to be voted on by the Board of Supervisors, to wit:

A total of 350 affirmative votes shall be required for the adoption of any resolution, local law, motion or proposal requiring a majority vote, and a total of 466 affirmative votes shall be required for the adoption of any resolution requiring a two-thirds vote.

#### SECTION 4. EFFECT OF OTHER LAWS OR ACTS

Any law, ordinance, resolution or other act to the extent inconsistent herewith shall be superceded by the within law.

#### SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof,

but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph or section thereof directly involved in the proceeding in which such adjudication shall have been rendered.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall become effective after proper filing in the Office of the Secretary of State *but not earlier than January 1, 1968.*
