Section 1. The annual salary of the Wayne County Superintendent of Highways shall be, and it is hereby increased from \$22,000 per year to \$22,300 effective January 1, 1977.

Section 2. The annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be and it is hereby increased from \$22,000 per year to \$22,300 effective January 1, 1977.

Section 3. The annual salary of the Personnel Officer shall be, and it is hereby increased from \$22,000 per year to \$22,300 effective January 1, 1977.

Section 4. The annual salary of the Director of Real Property Tax Service shall be, and it is hereby increased from \$18,000 per year to \$18,300 effective January 1, 1977.

Section 5. The annual salary of the County Attorney shall be and it is hereby increased from \$24,000 per year to \$24,300 effective January 1, 1977.

Section 6. The local law shall take effect immediately upon the date it is filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF WAYNE COUNTY  
LOCAL LAW NO. 3 - 1977, SUBJECT TO  
PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that Local Law No. 3-1977, entitled "A LOCAL LAW AFFECTING COMPENSATION OF COUNTY ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICERS DURING THEIR TERM OF OFFICE" was adopted by the Board of Supervisors, County of Wayne, on June 21, 1977, as follows:

SECTION 1. The annual salary of the Wayne County Superintendent of Highways shall be, and it is hereby increased from \$22,000 per year to \$22,300 effective January 1, 1977.

SECTION 2. The annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be and it is hereby increased from \$22,000 per year to \$22,300 effective January 1, 1977.

SECTION 3. The annual salary of the Personnel Officer shall be, and it is hereby increased from \$22,000 per year to \$22,300 effective January 1, 1977.

SECTION 4. The annual salary of the Director of Real Property Tax Service shall be, and it is hereby increased from \$18,000 per year to \$18,300 effective January 1, 1977.

SECTION 5. The annual salary of the County Attorney shall be and it is hereby increased from \$24,000 per year to \$24,300 effective January 1, 1977.

SECTION 6. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon the date it is filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.

NOTICE IS ALSO GIVEN, that this Local Law is subject to referendum on petition as provided by the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, and in the event that a lawful petition is not filed within forty-five days after the adoption of said law, it shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided in the Municipal Home Rule Law.
