NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW NO. 4-1992

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wayne County Local Law No. 4 for the year 1992 entitled "A local law in relation to residency requirements for the office of the coroner's physician" was adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Wayne on October 20, 1992, and was filed in the Office of the Secretary of State on October 26, 1992.

Local Law No. 4-1992 is fully set forth as follows:

LOCAL LAW NO. 4-1992
COUNTY OF WAYNE - STATE OF NEW YORK

A Local Law in relation to residency requirements for the office of coroner's physician.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAYNE, as follows:

SECTION 1.

The provisions of Section 3 of the Public Officers Law of the State of New York requiring a person to be a resident of the political subdivision or municipal corporation for which he shall be chosen or within which his official functions are required to be exercised shall not prevent a person from holding the office of coroner's physician provided that such person resides in Wayne County or in an adjoining county.

SECTION 2.

This local law shall take effect November 1, 1992.
