RE: Filing of Local Laws

Chapter 78 of the Laws of 1988 amended Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law in relation to the filing of local laws, effective May 15, 1988.

The revised filing requirements are:

1. File one certified copy with the County Clerk. (No change)
2. File three certified copies in the office of the Secretary of State. (Number of copies reduced from 4 to 3)

It is no longer necessary to file a certified copy of the local law in the office of the State Comptroller.

I presume that the office of the Secretary of State will be sending out new filing instructions in accordance with the new statutory change.

A local law amending Local Law No. 5-1985, as amended by Local Law No. 2-1988, in relation to regulating parking in the reserved parking area adjacent to the Pearl Street County Office Building.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the

SECTION 1.

Section 2 of Local Law No. 5-1985 entitled "A Local Law Designating a Reserved Parking Area Adjacent to Pearl Street County Office Building and Adopting Regulations Governing Parking in Such Area", as amended by Local Law No. 2-1988, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. The county-owned land immediately south of and adjacent to the County Office Building is hereby designated as a reserved parking area for the following designated persons:

This local law shall take effect immediately upon the date it is filed in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.
