**RESOLUTION NO. 535-03: ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW IN RELATION TO REGULATING PARKING IN THE RESERVED PARKING AREA ADJACENT TO THE PEARL STREET OFFICE BUILDING**

Mr. Fabino presented the following:

WHEREAS, a proposed local law in relation to regulating parking in the reserved parking area adjacent to the Pearl Street Office Building was presented to the Board of Supervisors on June 17, 2003; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed local law was held by the Board of Supervisors on July 15, 2003, in accordance with the notice of hearing duly posted and published in the manner prescribed by law; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, that said local law is hereby adopted to read as follows:

**COUNTY OF WAYNE - STATE OF NEW YORK  
LOCAL LAW NO. 5-2003**

A local law amending Local Law No. 5-1985, as amended by Local Law No. 2-1988, Local Law No. 4-1993 and Local Law No. 4-2002, in relation to regulating parking in the reserved parking area adjacent to the Pearl Street Office Building.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAYNE**, as follows:

**SECTION 1.**

Section 2 of Local Law No. 5-1985 entitled "A Local Law Designating A Reserved Parking Area Adjacent to Pearl Street County Office Building and Adopting Regulations Governing Parking in Such Area" as amended by Local Law No. 2-1988, Local Law No. 4-1993 and Local Law No. 4-2002, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. The county-owned land immediately south of and adjacent to the County Office Building is hereby designated as a reserved parking area for the following designated persons:

**SECTION 2.**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon the date it is filed in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby directed to number the local law in conformance with the filing requirements of the Secretary of State and to file the local law with the Secretary of State in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.
