RESOLUTION NO. 130-91

ADOPTING LOCAL LAW INCREASING SALARIES  
OF CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS

Mr. Prober presented the following:

WHEREAS, a proposed local law providing for changes in the salaries of certain County officers during their term of office was presented to the Board of Supervisors on January 15, 1991; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed local law was held by the Board of Supervisors on February 21, 1991, in accordance with the notice of hearing duly posted and published in the manner provided by law; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that said local law is hereby adopted, subject to permissive referendum, to read as follows:

COUNTY OF WAYNE - STATE OF NEW YORK

A Local Law providing for changes in the salaries of certain County officers during their term of office.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAYNE, as follows:

SECTION 1. The annual salary of the County Sheriff is hereby increased from \$39,000 to \$43,000, effective January 1, 1991.

SECTION 2. The annual salary of the County Clerk is hereby increased from \$35,000 to \$37,100, effective January 1, 1991.

SECTION 3. The annual salary of the County Attorney is hereby increased from \$51,500 to \$54,500, effective January 1, 1991.

SECTION 4. The annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services is hereby increased from \$50,380 to \$53,000, effective January 1, 1991.

SECTION 5. The annual salary of the Superintendent of Highways is hereby increased from \$42,525 to \$45,000, effective January 1, 1991.

SECTION 6. The annual salary of the Director of Real Property Tax Services is hereby increased from \$35,280 to \$37,396, effective January 1, 1991.

SECTION 7. The annual salary of the Planning Director is hereby increased from \$33,000 to \$35,000, effective January 1, 1991.

SECTION 8. The annual salary of the Personnel Officer is hereby increased from \$30,000 to \$33,500, effective January 1, 1991.

SECTION 9. The annual salary of the Fire Coordinator is hereby increased from \$14,550 to \$15,423, effective January 1, 1991.

SECTION 10. An incumbent holding a position specified in this local law at any time during the period from January 1, 1991, until the time when basic annual salaries are first paid pursuant to this local law for such service in excess of the compensation actually received therefore, shall be entitled to a lump-sum payment for the difference between the salary to which such incumbent was entitled for such service and the compensation actually received after this local law becomes effective.

SECTION 11. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, part or provision of this local law shall for any reason be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgement shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its effect and operation

to the clause, sentence, paragraph, part of provision thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment is rendered.

SECTION 12. This local law is adopted subject to a permissive referendum, and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall give public notice thereof in the manner required by law.

SECTION 13. This local law shall take effect on the date it is filed in the office of the Secretary of State as provided in Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.  
and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby directed to give notice of the adoption of the local law subject to permissive referendum in the manner provided by law; and be it further

RESOLVED, that if no valid petition requesting a referendum is filed within the period of time prescribed by law, the Clerk of the Board is directed to number the local law in conformance with the filing requirements of the Secretary of State, and to file the local law in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

Mr. Spickerman moved the adoption of the resolution. Seconded by Mr. DeLisio. Upon roll call, all Supervisors voted Aye. Absent - Supervisors Carlson and Wheeler. The Chairman declared the resolution adopted.
