The Wayne County Board of Elections (WC BOE) have adopted the following policies and procedures regarding Early Voting.

All early voting will take place at the WC BOE office. The hours are below. Our office will be set up as a polling site, following all regulations as an election day polling site. We will have at least one handicapped voting booth and plenty of tables and privacy screens for voters to vote their ballots. Once the voter is verified, they sign their name, are given the appropriate ballot in a privacy sleeve and shown where to vote their ballot. Once the voter has completed the ballot, we will have 3 ICE voting machines where they will cast their ballot. If the voter is inactive or is a registered voter within NYS, they will be given an affidavit ballot to vote. The affidavit ballots will be canvassed with all affidavits from election day. If a ballot is unscannable and the voter wishes to cast as is, they will be instructed to insert the ballot into the emergency ballot (EB) slot on the machine. The EB's will be canvassed with the early voting results. At the close of each day, each machine containing the voted ballots and all affidavits will be secured in a locked storage room within the BOE office. The room may not be unlocked unless there is one Republican and one Democrat present. Results from early voting will not be printed and announced until 9 PM November 5<sup>th</sup>. Voter history will be done daily and uploaded to NYSVoter daily. If e-poll books are used, we will stamp in red ink each night, VOTED EARLY in the appropriate voters signature box of the paper poll book.

We feel that our board is fortunate to have only one early voting site for our staff to manage and maintain accurate poll book records to ensure voters are only allowed to vote once in each election.
