Wayne County Public Health, has scheduled flu clinics for **ages 6 months - adult**. If you can receive flu vaccine at your doctor's office, you should do so. The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommends that the following priority groups receive vaccine:

Influenza Vaccination is recommended for the following target groups:

- Everyone 6 months and older should get a flu vaccine with or without chronic medical conditions.
- All household contacts and caregivers of persons at high risk for severe complications from flu.
- Pregnant women
- All Health care workers
- All Household contacts and caregivers of children 0-59 months of age.
- Anyone else who wants to be protected from the flu

Children needing the vaccine should contact their pediatrician's office.

Wayne County Public Health Department will also have flu shots available in our office during open hours. Appointments are encouraged, but walk-ins are welcome.

When you come to clinic, please bring **all** your insurance cards. The cost of the flu vaccine is \$50.00 and the pneumonia vaccine is \$135.0. For those without insurance a sliding fee scale will be provided. Please **do not** come early to clinic, and please come dressed appropriately to receive a shot in your arm. Pneumonia vaccine will be available to those who meet the criteria.
