Wayne County (Lyons, NY) – Wayne County Public Health is confirming at this time another COVID-19 related death. This individual was in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 and onset of symptoms occurred quickly. A post-mortem test was conducted and came back positive for COVID-19. First responders who were part of the call to this home have been notified and placed under quarantine at this time. Wayne County Public Health would like to extend its sincerest condolences to the family.

Wayne County Public Health would like to stress to its residents that if you are experiencing signs and symptoms of COVID-19 you should call your primary care physician or health care provider immediately.

We can also confirm our total number of COVID-19 cases currently stands at 90. At this time, 64 of the 90 confirmed cases have resolved (recovered). We can also confirm that we have received 2268 processed tests results, with 2178 of those results being negative. Wayne County Public Health can also confirm that 3 individuals are currently requiring hospitalization at this time.

The 90 Wayne County individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 are:

- 2 Individuals under the age of 10
- 12 Individuals in their 20s
- 13 Individuals in their 30s
- 14 Individuals in their 40s
- 18 Individuals in their 50s
- 15 Individuals in their 60s
- 11 Individuals in their 70s
- 4 Individuals in their 80s
- 1 Individual in their 90s
